### Here are a few things you should know:

- **NO eating or drinking in costumes.** If you are wearing a smock to cover your costume, dry snacks like crackers are permitted. Please only drink water. The costumes cost more than the rental fee, and we would like to keep them in pristine condition.
- **NO panties are to be worn with costumes**
- **Costumes are to be returned to the stage immediately after the Saturday performance**

Typically, we do not send videos of choreography to students because they should be working on their own (rather than relying on copying) to get it into their muscle memory. Practice also nurtures growth and achievement. However, this year is unique with irregular ferries and many student absences. We will be accommodating a couple of classes with videos of missed choreography.... this is not a free pass to miss classes and is not something we will put into regular practice. We will be sending ONLY the newest parts of choreography to ONLY our Jr. Musical Theater class and Ballet 1 class. Anyone else wishing to have video clips of their dance should speak to their instructor to see if it's something we can accommodate.
